### HICKORY

#### **The Salvation Army of Greater Hickory** (750 3rd Ave Place SE, Hickory)

Offers two food services at the Crisis Help Center:

1. **Food Boxes:** individuals can receive the food box assistance once every two months. Boxes include canned good items and frozen meats. Individuals need to complete a brief application and be at/or below poverty level.  
Assistance on Monday afternoons 1 – 4 p.m. or Wednesday mornings 9 a.m. – 12 p.m.
2. **Loaves and Fishes** (produce distribution): This assistance is a drive thru service and is offered every Wednesday from 1:30 p.m. - 2:30 p.m. If they've never been here, they would need to complete an application.
3. At The Shelter of Hope – Breakfast: 7 days a week – 7 to 7:30 a.m.  
Supper: 7 days a week – 5 p.m.

1. Ashure **Hunger Relief** Programs require a personal interview with a case manager. Programs provide food assistance for families experiencing food insecurity. ALL hunger programs run for a six-month cycle, with a required renewal for the program to continue. Programs provide sufficient quantities per household size. Open to all Catawba County residents.
2. There is a **Student Hunger Prevention** Program available to Catawba County resident students and their families.

**The Corner Table Soup Kitchen (112 N Main Ave, Newton)**

1. Community Kitchen: **Hot meals** Monday – Friday, 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. Guests have the option to dine in or take their meal to go.
2. Also have free food items available out back. They vary and can include breads, pastries, drinks, meat, produce etc. Our Community Kitchen also sends guests home each Friday with a to-go-bag to cover for another meal. Also delivers lunch to **Strong Life Ministries** Monday-Friday by 12 p.m.
3. **Frozen Meals:** available to pick-up Monday – Thursday, 8 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. and Friday 8 a.m. – 1 p.m.
4. **Backpack Program:** Any student in need in Catawba County can enroll in our Backpack Program. Application online, or they can go through their teacher or guidance counselor. A food bags are sent home each weekend of the school year. During the summer, food bags available at all seven County Library branches. Call: 828-464-0355
